

Criteria 2012 Sea Pines Junior Heritage  
(BOYS)

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to male amateur golfers who: (a) will not reach their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by midnight of August 31, 2011 and (b) are currently enrolled between grades 8-12 during the 2011/12 academic school year or (c) otherwise accepted by the selection committee.

**Amateur Status:** All players must conform to the USGA Rules of Amateur Status as specified in the USGA Rules of Golf.

Category 10	Top 10 in the following 2011 tournaments: Thunderbird International Jr., FootJoy Boys Invitational, The Ping Invitational, Junior Players Championship, HP Boys Junior Championship, and Junior Invitational

- Category 18            Runner-up in Open tournaments  
Third place in Open tournaments  
(Tournament must be ranking in the Top 125 of Golfweek  
Tournament rankings)
- Additions:            Up to four local / regional players may be added by the entry  
committee

Example:            If 43 players apply from the first 9 categories, all of those applicants will be accepted (this includes up to 4 local/regional players accepted by the entry committee). If 6 other players have applied from category 10, then 2 of those will be accepted to reach 45 total (entry committee decisions are final). The committee will rank the other 4 players not selected in category 10 as alternates. The remaining applicants in category 11, plus those in the rest of the categories will be marked as alternates.

Note: The Sea Pines Junior Heritage entry committee reserves the right to review the selection criteria yearly and make changes as necessary.
